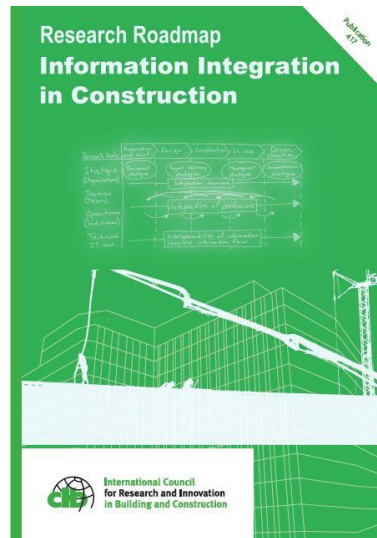




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New CIB Research Roadmap TG90 – Information Integration in Construction



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Introduction

The CIB Task Group, TG90 – Information Integration in Construction, has published their Research Roadmap.

This Roadmap is developed for a challenging Global environment where fundamental paradigms such as data generation and analysis, are shifting at a seismic rate, while change in Construction Industries across the Globe is, in the main, confined to large-scale projects and slow.

The authors conceptualized data integration by taking the realities of 'doing business' in construction into consideration. The emergent framework facilitates the discussion of knowledge and data integration at organisational, team, operational and technical levels across key project phases. This approach recognizes that business is done through projects but change can only come about if appropriate organizational structures and processes are put in place.

Last, but not least, the authors strived to ensure that data integration was not considered solely from a technical perspective. Organisational, team and individual aspects of data integration were integrated in the research framework.
